This theme will serve to frame key events and activities throughout Canada's tenure.

OBJECTIVES

Galvanize political, financial, technical and material commitments toward the fulfillment of the humanitarian and development needs identified by the MIRPS countries

Increase international visibility of MIRPS, and engagement in support of MIRPS from a wider range of actors (i.e. State and non-State actors)

Reinforce the Support Platform as an effective mechanism to mobilize comprehensive responses for the forced displacement situation in the region
