



Below is the schedule of sessions and deliverables for the 2025 MIRPS Regional Technical Team (RTT) on Jobs and Livelihoods. This schedule is subject to changes—in both content and format—as deemed appropriate by the lead country and MIRPS member states.

Month	Session
April	Virtual session among governments to present updated information on National Employment Systems (based on a virtual form for updating information on National Employment Systems and access to work permits).
May	Virtual session to present progress on the implementation of the first phase of the labor competencies recognition strategy: i) Adjusted strategy and action plan; ii) Certification/ recognition pathway and key aspects for dissemination; iii) Basic variables and indicators for tracking migrant populations in employment services; iv) Proposal for a pilot certification project.
June	Virtual working session with civil society organizations and refugee-led organizations on initiatives for labor market integration.
July	Joint virtual session with the Regional Technical Team on Local Governance to coordinate initiatives for labor market integration.
August	Regional forum on labor market integration, in coordination with civil society, the private sector, and academia.
September	Virtual session to present progress on the implementation of the labor competencies recognition strategy, including updates on pilot certification projects.
Additional events to the RTT working sessions	 Technical workshop to promote a strategy for recognizing the labor competencies of people in situations of mobility in Central America, the Dominican Republic, and Mexico, in cooperation with the International Labour Organization (ILO) (<i>participation limited to representatives of vocational training and labor competency certification institutions from Central America, the Dominican Republic, and Mexico</i>). Learning event on labor market integration, in collaboration with the MIRPS Support Platform (<i>to be determined</i>).
